



Procedure for Beacon Fell Adventures sessions regarding Covid- 19 restrictions

(January 2022)

(In line with Government and Lancashire policies)

- All sessions are booked online or via email and where possible all payment made online via Bacs.
- Those attending any activities will be asked to leave their details for track and trace purposes. These details will be disposed of (shredded) after 21 days.
- Customers asked to refrain from visiting the fell if they demonstrate any Covid-19 symptoms -new or persistent cough, loss of taste/smell and or high temperature.
- Please bring your own sanitiser and use this at beginning, end and before eating.
- On arrival meet near or in the visitors centre- demarcated by our flag.
- Please adhere to current national, and if applicable local, social distancing guidance.
- All sessions will take place outside, for most of the time and where possible in quieter areas away from more crowded places. Signs will be erected to ensure other members of the public do not use the selected area.
- If we use the environment room, we will ensure that there is enough room to social distance, the double doors to the outside will remain open and major touch points in the room will be cleaned before and after using.
- You may wear your own facemasks at any point during the session.
- All equipment wiped down/washed or left for 72 hours from previous use.
- Activities will be planned to ensure social distancing can be adhered to.
- Customers may be asked to leave the activity or the fell if procedures are not followed.
- Customers will be reminded to listen to instructions, stay within set boundaries, do not put anything in their mouths including hands, take care of yourself, each other and the fell which includes social distancing.

Use of toilets.

- Beacon Fell public toilets undergo cleaning on a daily basis by LCC staff.
- Beacon Fell Adventures customers asked to sanitize their hands before use.
- Adhere to social distancing restrictions whilst waiting for the toilets if applicable.

First Aid

- Where possible, parents or BFA customers undertake their own first aid.
- Simple first aid equipment e.g. tissues, wipes, plasters to be provided by BFA staff.
- If BFA staff need to administer first aid they will wear PPE including mask, gloves and apron.
- All used first aid equipment, including PPE, will be disposed of in a bag into a bin with a lid.

NB

In booking onto a session or party with Beacon Fell Adventures you are agreeing to conform with these procedures.

The procedures will be regularly reviewed and updated as restrictions and procedures change either nationally or locally.

All parking is free when booked and attending BFA activities. No need to pay for parking or touch parking meters.
