



Beacon Fell Adventures Staff responsibilities:

- Advise visiting staff/visit leader/parents on appropriate activities prior to their visit to the fell.
- We will plan, organise and resource activities to a high standard.
- We will provide risk assessments and procedures for visiting adults.
- We will follow safety procedures both before, during and after the group visits.
- Ensure BFA staff qualifications, DBS, First Aid and Insurance remain up to date.
- When on child care adventure days we will act in accordance to “in loco parentis”.
- We endeavour to provide high quality, friendly outdoor experiences for visiting groups.
- Safety is paramount - it will not be compromised, therefore activities may be postponed/adapted or cancelled due to any presenting risk.
- We encourage responsible and positive attitudes to the natural environment as an integral part of all visits.
- We hope that everyone can learn, play and rejuvenate outdoors up at Beacon Fell.

**Visiting adults (teaching staff, parents, party hosts)
responsibilities:**

- Relevant up to date information about the children and adults attending the session which may affect their participation during a visit. (Medical, dietary, behaviour and learning needs etc.)
- Parties and school visits - the leading adults from the group are responsible for managing the behaviour of attendees.
- Provide clear objectives/intentions for their visit.
- Cooperate with and follow our procedures.
- Ensure that attendees are clothed appropriately for activities/weather.
- Ensure attendees have appropriate food, drink etc. for the length of the session.

**Attendees (children, pupils and party goers)
responsibilities:**

- Listen to Beacon Fell Adventures staff and follow instructions.
- Remain within any boundaries set.
- Do not put anything in your mouth during the session (unless drink, snack, camp fire food etc.)
- Take care of yourself, others and the natural environment.
